Range Rules

(as approved by the East End Rod & Gun Club July 2, 2008)
Reviewed November 17, 2009

1. Know and obey all range commands.
2. Range (red) flag must be flown prior to commencement of any shooting on the range.
3. Shooting will take place on designated ranges only.
4. All firearms must remain unloaded with actions open except on the firing line.
5. A handgun may be carried on one's person only in a holster designated for the safe and secure retention of the handgun, a gun case or gun cart. No handgun will be removed from a holster except at the firing line in accordance with range rules. All handguns will be carried in a manner conforming to State Law.
6. No military armor piercing or tracer ammunition may be used on any range. Firing of 50 caliber BMG, 416 Barrett, or other 50 BMG variations or derivatives is prohibited except for law enforcement personnel with written board approval. Incendiary rounds, tracers or exploding targets are NOT allowed. If you use them, you will be personally liable for any resultant fire or damage.
7. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed on or behind any firing line, or in any building adjacent to any range while shooting is in progress. Violators will be asked to leave premises. No fees will be refunded.
8. All vehicles are restricted to open designated roadways and parking areas only.
9. No firing on rifle range anytime there is equipment or personnel in field to the south of that range. In the event any equipment or personnel are observed beyond down range boundaries, all shooters will cease fire until the area is clear.
10. Maximum speed limit: 10 m.p.h.
11. Open fires in designated fire pits only.
12. No littering.
13. No shooter 18 or younger may use range facilities without adult supervision.
14. All pets must be on a leash, and no pets in any building during range use.
15. Ear and eye protection must be worn by all shooters.
16. No full auto firing may be used on any range without prior written approval of the Board of Directors.
17. All high power rifle, jacketed and semi-jacketed ammunition shall be fired only from the fixed benches in a southerly direction towards target berms.
